6. What do you think it means to “believe in vain”? Who do you know that has believed things in vain?

7. In verse 3 what Scripture is Paul referring to? What Scriptures can we refer to now concerning the resurrection of Christ?

8. From verse 12 what false teaching is being spread among the Corinthians? What false teaching(s) are we dealing with today?

9. From verses 12-19 how do you connect Christ’s resurrection with your own hope of resurrection from death?

10. Paul puts the resurrection in perspective with the Second Coming and the end of time. What does it mean to you that in the end Christ will be victorious?
