4. From verses 19-21 how do the lives of the rich man and Lazarus compare while they were on earth? From verses 22-24 how did they compare after they both died?

5. Why do you think Lazarus was qualified for heaven while the rich man was kept out?

6. How does Jesus describe the place of comfort where Lazarus found himself? How is the pit described where the rich man found himself?

7. While in the pit, what are the various things that the rich man is longing for?

8. Why can't Lazarus help the rich man in the pit? Why can't someone leave Hades and go tell the rich man's five brothers about how bad hell is?

9. Regarding the rich man's five brothers, what does Abraham tell the rich man in verse 29? What are the implications of this statement?

10. Why would listening to Moses and the Prophets be sufficient to find salvation? Who is Jesus referring to in verse 31?

11. In this passage Jesus doesn't seem to be sharing a parable but an actual occurrence in that actual names are used in it's telling. What might be some of the reasons why Jesus would share this account with His disciples?
