Getting Started

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
2. If you were laid off from work today or your job was terminated, where would you go to get yourself together?
3. When was a time where you didn't really know who you were talking to? What was the outcome?

Digging Deeper

4. What do you think caused these two disciples to leave town? Fear? Disillusionment? Overload? Loneliness? Despair?

5. This event took place 3 days after the crucifixion. Why didn't they recognize Jesus?

6. In verses 19-24, what are the two disciples talking about as they walk? What was their tone of voice? What hopes have been dashed? What plans might they be making?

7. From your knowledge of Old Testament prophecy, what passages might Jesus have discussed with them in verses 25-27? Why did Jesus do a roundabout Bible study rather than just reveal his identity immediately and directly?

8. In verse 29 why did the two disciples urge Jesus to stay with them that evening?

9. What opened the eyes of these two disciples? Why did the two disciples want to return to Jerusalem?

10. What has happened to the other disciples in Jerusalem that has caused them to change their minds from verse 11 about Jesus's resurrection? Why was there a special appearance to Simon Peter?
