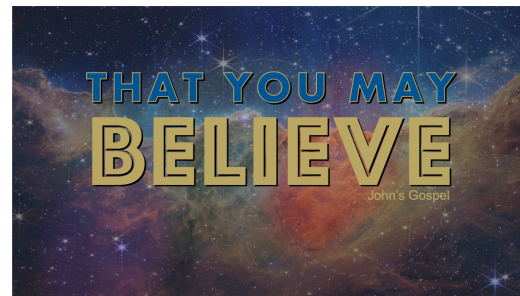
12. How has God “made straight” the way of the Lord in your life?

### Behold the Lamb of God John 1:19-34 For the Week of June 4, 2023

#### Getting Started

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend’s message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
2. Have you ever been embarrassed by mistaking a stranger for an acquaintance? What happened?
3. What is your favorite animal? What is your least favorite? Why?

### **Digging Deeper**

4. What questions do the priests and Levites ask John the Baptist? What were they trying to find out?

5. Why do you think John answers so abruptly? What would you have said in this situation?

6. What is John's purpose in life? (V 22-23; 26-27; Isaiah 40:3-5)

7. How did John initially describe Jesus in verses 23-27?

8. What does John mean by calling Jesus the "Lamb of God" in verse 29? (Exodus 12:1-13; Isaiah 53:7)

9. What does John mean by calling Jesus the "Son of God" in verse 34? (Psalm 2)

10. How would you describe what John saw in verses 32-34? How did God indicate to John who the Messiah was? Why is this so significant?

11. How would you describe or differentiate between the nature of John's Baptism (by water) with that of Jesus' baptism (by the Holy Spirit)?
