#### Getting Started

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
2. What is the funniest thing you've ever witnessed at a wedding?
3. If you are married, was there any drama surrounding your wedding? What happened?

### **Digging Deeper**

4. Weddings in Jesus' day were important social events. Relatives and townspeople would gather to celebrate, often for up to a week. Why do you think Jesus attended this particular wedding?

5. To run out of wine at such an important event would have been a great social blunder. Up to this point Jesus was not known as a "miracle worker," why does his mother approach him about the shortage of wine in verse 3?

6. How would you describe how Jesus and Mary relate to each other in verses 3-5?

7. In verse 7, what was strange about the request that Jesus made to the servants concerning the filling of the six large jars with water? Why might the servants have been put off by the request?

8. What was the reaction of the master of the banquet regarding the water that had been turned into wine? Why was this so unexpected?

9. What is so remarkable about this account is that only a few people actually knew what Jesus had done. From this passage who are the only ones who knew about Jesus' miracle? Why did Jesus not want to go public with this particular miracle?

10. What was so significant about this first miracle that Jesus performed at the very beginning of His ministry? (Exodus 7:14-25)

11. According to verse 11, in what way was Jesus' glory revealed through what took place at the wedding in Cana?
