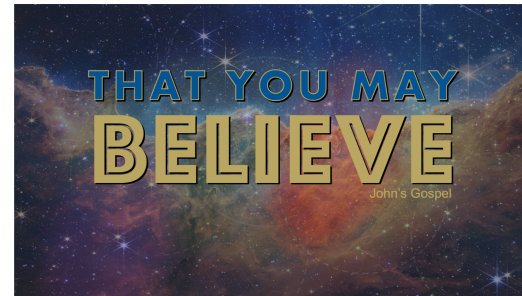
12. Have you come to the conviction that Jesus is the Son of God, the Savior of the world?

Getting Started

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?

2. Are you more like the salesman who could sell a refrigerator to an Eskimo, or more like the Eskimo who buys one?

3. In what situations do you find it hard to talk about Christianity or religion?

Digging Deeper

4. What are some of the miraculous signs Jesus has done in John's Gospel? How do the prophecies from Isaiah 53:1 and 6:10 account for the people's disbelief in spite of the signs?

5. What are the consequences of choosing not to believe? What impact on a person does this have in this life and in eternity?

6. What is the author implying about Jesus in verse 41 (V8:58; Isaiah 6:1-13)

7. What inhibits the leaders from speaking? How does this illustrate verses 12:25-26? Of what value is the approval of men? How does this compare with the approval of God?

8. Who does Jesus say sent Him into the world? Who is Jesus claiming to be?

9. The word "judge" is used 4 times in these verses. What does Jesus mean when He says "I did not come to judge the world, but to save the world"?

10. What is Jesus emphasizing in verses 47-50 as His last public statement about Himself? What will ultimately judge us in the end?

11. We have now completed a study of 12 chapters of the Gospel of John. What can you conclude about Jesus from what you have learned about His life, ministry, miracles, messages, and His desire to save the lost?
