14. In light of verse 14:6 how would you respond to someone who says, "There are many ways to God"?

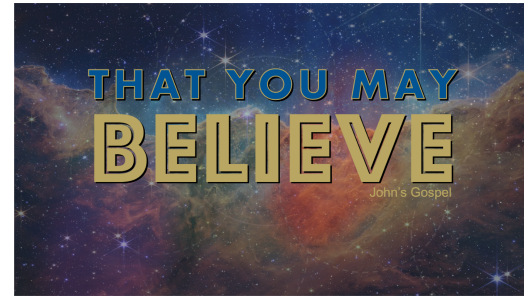
15. How has the Holy Spirit been the best Counselor you have ever had?

Getting Started

2. What is your favorite room in your house?
3. Can you remember a time when you got lost? What happened?

Digging Deeper

4. According to John 13:36; 14:6, 8, 22 what problems are the disciples struggling with? Which problem is the most troubling to the disciples and why?

5. In verse 2 Jesus says that He is on His way to prepare a place for us. Why are we going to need a dwelling place in our Father's house? How is it going to be provided for us? What will it be like when we at last arrive there? (Revelation 21:1-4)

6. How would you put Jesus' statement in 14:6-7 in your own words?

7. What evidence does Jesus give for His claims in verses 9-14?

8. What does Jesus mean in verse 12 that we will do "greater works than these?" Does this apply only to the apostles or are we also included? (Acts 2:38-41)

9. How are the disciples to show love to each other? (13:34) To Jesus? (14:15) Why is this idea repeated four times in verses 15, 21 and 25-27?

10. What do you learn about the Holy Spirit in verses 16-17 and 25-27? Our Lord gives the Holy Spirit two special names in verses 16 and 17. What do they tell us of the Spirit's work in us?

11. In this passage what three conditions must be met in our prayers for God to answer them? Why are they necessary?

12. What does it mean to pray in Jesus' name? What should be our attitude regarding whose will is to be done?

13. Where does our peace come from? What do we need in order to be at peace?
